

Going to Beavers



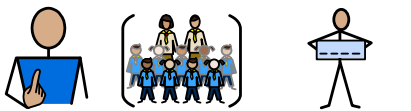
I am going to Beavers.

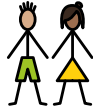
Leaders



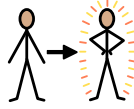
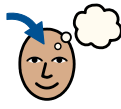
The leaders are called



They are there to help me and the other children.

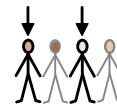
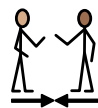


Young Leaders are older children and are there to help.

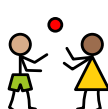


Young Leaders learn how to become a leader when they are older.

Beavers may wear a uniform.



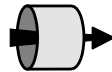
The uniform is a blue jumper or blue polo shirt.

I can earn badges for my uniform.

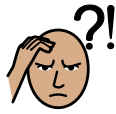
Help

I will listen to the leader's instructions.

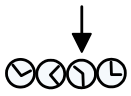

Sometimes, I might be in a small group with other children.

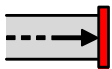


These small groups are called Lodges.

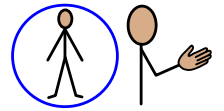
