BUILD A WILD CITY

Our partners Pets at Home explain how to gather a gang of wildlife critters around your meeting place

Suitable for Beavers and Cubs

You will need: Paving slab, brick or rock Plastic storage box Leaf and

- twig litter Straw • Recyclable paper carrier bag • Bricks • Shallow dish
- (ceramic or metal) Stone
 Water



HEDGEHOG HOME

Cut a door and window into the storage box and hand over to the young people. They can turn it upside down, leave a bed of straw and leaf litter inside, and spread the opened paper bag over it before covering with leaf litter.



FROG PAD

In a cool, shaded area, dig a shallow bowl shape with a short trench/ pathway heading out of it. Carefully cover with a paving slab, brick or rock.

In a flat spot, sheltered from the wind, place three bricks in a triangle. Place your dish, with a stone in it, over the top and half-fill it with water. If the water freezes, turn out the ice and refill your dish with fresh water.
