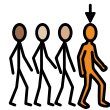
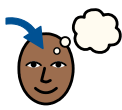
They help Explorers to plan activities and achieve badges and awards.



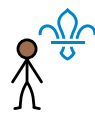

Some Explorers do the Young Leaders' Scheme and become Young Leaders.

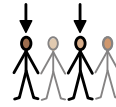
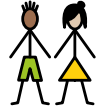
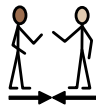

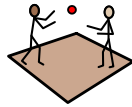


They help run activities with Squirrels, Beavers, Cubs or Scouts.

When I arrive I'll meet lots of new young people and maybe some from school.

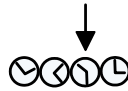

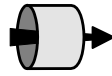
At Explorers, I will wear



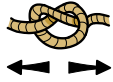
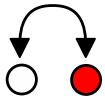
Leaders may wear a uniform with a light beige shirt or blouse and badges.

I can earn badges for my uniform.

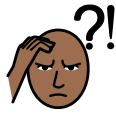
Help

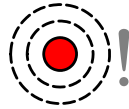
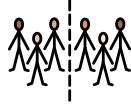

Patrols



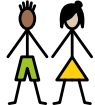
My Explorer Unit might be organised into smaller groups of young people.



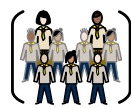
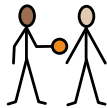
