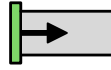
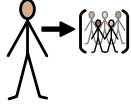


The Grand Howl

The Grand Howl is a special way of saying 'hello' to the leaders.



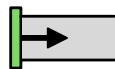
I will get into a cricle or semi circle with the other Cubs.



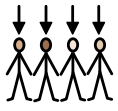
Akela (or another leader) will be in the middle.

The Grand Howl starts when the leader's arms are lifted up and then down.



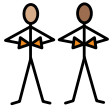
All the Cubs squat like the wolves in The Jungle Book story.



In the story the wolves crouch at Council Rock.



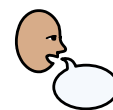
I will say or shout:



'Akela we will do our best!'



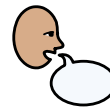
It is ok to shout during The Grand Howl.



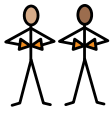
A Sixer will stand at alert, salute the leader and say or shout:



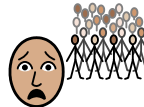
'Cubs! Do your best!'



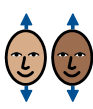
I will stand and salute with the other Cubs, and say or shout:



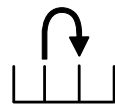
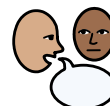
'We will do our best!'
