You could also use Menti or other software if you prefer. ● Breakout rooms - ensure you are familiar with the use of Breakout rooms in teams and zoom as this is used in the activities.

01:25 to 01:50 25 mins	<p>Walking debate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explain that this activity is to promote discussion and there is a continuum of answers. Ask each question and get responses via the poll; get people to explain why they have chosen their answer (true/false/middle) 	PowerPoint slide 50-59
01:50 to 02:20 20 mins	<p>Medical conditions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Split into five break out rooms, giving each a scenario (either ask them to screen shot or share the PowerPoint to the breakout room) Get them to discuss (5 mins) key points on the treatment and feedback (15 mins). They can also note down any questions they have as a group. Heart attack Stroke Diabetes Anaphylaxis Asthma 	PowerPoint slides 60-62
02:20 to 02:30 10 mins	<p>Extremes of Temperature</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explain that a symptom will appear on the screen and they need to identify if it is heat exhaustion, hypothermia or both. You could use the chat to ask people to respond - H = hot, C = cold and B = both or you could use a poll Run through the treatment for Heat exhaustion and Hypothermia - you could use the chat for suggestions <p><i>This is additional to the first response syllabus so can be omitted if time does not allow.</i></p>	PowerPoint slides - 63-65
